On-line registration is \$.50 less per event

Entry Fees: paid by 4/22 to 5/16: 13/event for first 5 events. \$5/(each additional event).

5/17 to 6/1 \$15/event for first 5 events. \$5/(each additional event).

6/2 to 6/5: \$17/event for first 5 events. \$5/(each additional event).

Meet Day Registration: \$19/event for first 5 events. \$6/(each additional event).

Commemorative T-shirts for first 100 entering at least (2) events. \$10 on meet day.

USATF Association Awards: Current USATF SC Association members will be awarded USATF Association medals for top 3 members in the Open category (18-29) and Masters 5-year categories (30-100+). To be eligible for USATF Awards you must have a valid USATF Membership. Please enter your USATF# during registration.

GTC Medals will also be given to the top 3 in each event in all age groups. Open (18-29) and 5 year Masters age groups. Relays are 10 year age groups.

NOTES: Throwers will be responsible for their own implements. New this year will be the requirement for athletes to have implements weighed before their events and afterwards, if a record is broken. **Pole Vault:** Unfortunately, there will be no pole vault. It lost hundreds per year in last 3 years because participation was too low. In 2017, there were only 10 entrants and 7 participants.

Refunds: There will be no refunds for meet cancellation due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances. If at all possible, the event will be rescheduled for the following week. If the meet cannot be rescheduled, entrants will receive at maximum a 50% credit to the 2019 meet, if it is held. Otherwise, there will be no refunds or credits. We have never had to cancel or postpone the meet since its inception.
