



USATF-SC Coaches Education L1 & L2 Scholarship Grants for 2021 - 2022

USATF-SC will be awarding scholarship grants to association members to assist them in qualifying as USATF level one and level two coaches. Scholarship grants will be issued to selected qualified USATF-SC members as applications are received until funds are exhausted. USATF-SC L1 Scholarship Grants 2021-2022:

To qualify for an L1 grant (covers the \$210 for registration) you must meet the following criteria:

Be at least 18 years of age

Have a current USATF South Carolina membership

USATF-SC L2 Scholarship Grants - 2021-2022

To qualify for an L2 grant (covers the roughly \$520 cost for the L2 class and the required L2 online sport science class) you must meet the following criteria:

Be at least 18 years of age

Have a current USATF South Carolina membership

Have successfully completed an L-1 course.

In addition to the basic information Please provide:

Which event group you plan to study.

Your coaching experience to date, including any club or team affiliations

Your plans for future coaching

Your gender, and minority status if any

We will verify information such as compliance with the L-1 requirement so please make sure your USATFConnect profile is updated.

All Grant Applications will be reviewed by the Association's Coaching Education

Committee and you will be notified of acceptance/rejection as quickly as we can manage.

Grants are intended for new applicants and will not be awarded to members who have received a previous grant in the same category - L1 or L2 (i.e.- previous L1 recipients are encouraged to apply for a new L2 grant, however, previous L2 recipients are not eligible for an L1 or another L2 grant). Preference will be given to active coaches in USATF-SC. Equality and diversity are goals for USATF- SC, therefore female and minority coaches are encouraged to apply. Grants are reimbursement grants, meaning that they will be paid after an accepted applicant has completed and passed the L1/L-2 course.

Note: The L1 or L2 grants can be applied towards an L1 or L2 course taken/to be taken at any time from August 2021 thru July 2022. Please watch the USATF website for announcements of more L1 or L2 courses online this year and next.
