Speaking of athletes, we had some fantastic performances at the meets. A list of the All Americans at the USATF National Junior Olympic Championships is at the end of this newsletter.

Despite poor weather conditions (rain/storm the night before delaying the start by an hour and lots of mud), SC athletes had great success! MPTC (Mt. Pleasant Track Club) had 12 individual All-Americans and 2 age group teams on the podium (8 and under Boys 2nd, and 9-10 Boys 2nd) and Brooklyn Cox, unattached 9-10 Girl was 2nd overall. Incidentally, this is the 5th year in a row MPTC 8 and under Boys have been on the podium at Nationals, and 4 years for their 9-10 boys. Congratulations!

There is one performance in particular that warrants mentioning again. A new long jump record was set at the 2021 USATF SC Association Youth Track & Field Championships!

New South Carolina State Record

Chantice Burton of Irmo, and a member of **The Storm Track Club**, set a new South Carolina Long Jump record for 9-10 Girls at 3.98m. Ms.Burton's jump of 3.98m eclipsed the previous record of 3.94m set in 2005 by Aubreya Smith of Spartanburg.

In another bit of news, we are working with USC to have them host a 2022 USATF South Carolina Association Youth Indoor Championship. Look for details coming soon.
