Notes:

1. Referee certifications, and the requirements are for each individual discipline: Track Referee, Field Referee, Combined Events Referee, LDR/Off-Track Referee, and Race Walk Referee.
2. Should be a National or Master-level official in many, if not all, of the appropriate individual disciplines.
3. Must be **Referee – Grade 1** for at least 2 years and have worked a minimum of 10 meets at that level.
4. Must be **Combined Events Coordinator – Grade 1** for at least 2 years and have worked a minimum of 6 meets at that level.
5. Must be **Combined Events Coordinator – Grade 2** for at least 2 years and have worked a minimum of 8 meets at that level.
6. Should be a National or Master-level official in multiple disciplines, ideally covering both Track and Field events.
7. Must be **Technical Manager – Grade 1** for at least 2 years and have worked meets at that level.
